Walk to North Ponds Park (.7 miles)

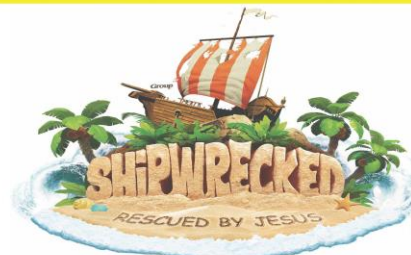
Walk 1 to 6 laps around North Ponds Park, walk back to Webster Baptist Church to finish!
