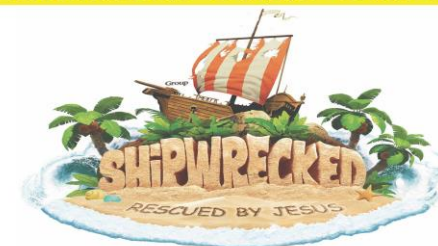
1. Sign-ups to help with the church rummage sale...volunteers to set-up, and work at the rummage sale are needed! Contact Jay Baker with questions.
