Cleaning Kits / Flood Buckets - URGENT NEED!

Recent flooding in Seneca County and throughout Pennsylvania has caused a shortage of UMCOR Cleaning/flood buckets within the Upper New York Conference.

Additionally, with hurricane season upon us - there is a need for these buckets throughout this county and beyond as well, as the current supplies are getting used.

UNY Mission Central HUB is in great need of UMCOR cleaning kit supplies and help assembling and verifying buckets. While some of these buckets are used to help our own area, they're also used around the world. According to Mike Block, Director of Missional Engagement, and Joe Auslander, UNY Conference Disaster Response Coordinator, warehouse contents are limited, and help is critical at this time.

There are specific supplies and sizes for the supplies - for these buckets. Please pick up a printed list of supplies/instructions in the Communications Center. If you can't quite fill a bucket on your own - consider asking a friend or family member to go in with you.

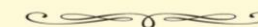
